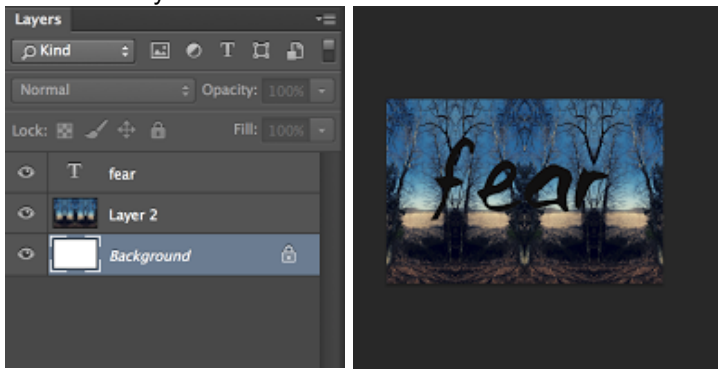
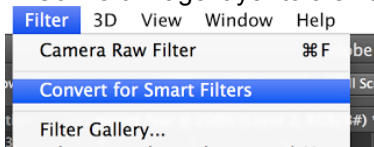


## Words Flash Cards PS Challenge (DVC Exam)

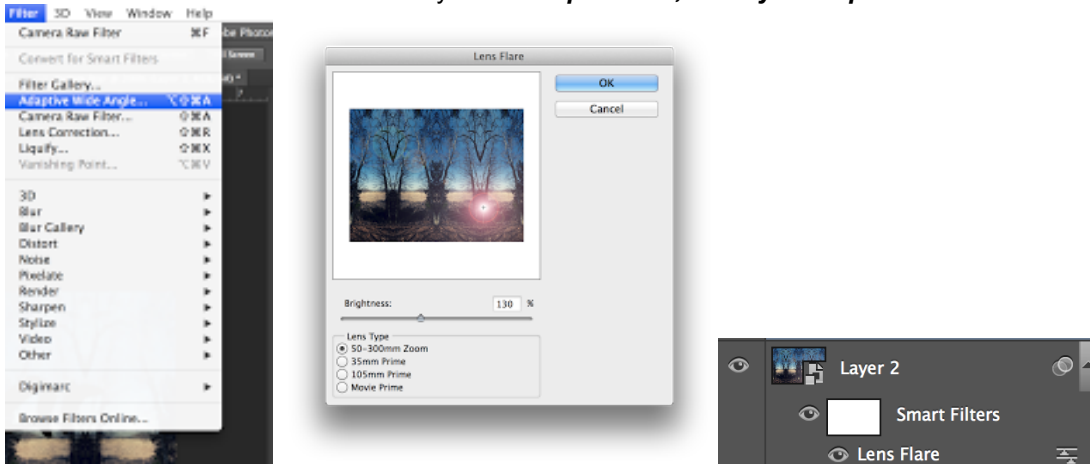
1. Open a new 6X4 size resolution 72 dpi, color RGB, document in Photoshop.
2. Write one of these words using a typeface that reflects the mood of the word:  
You may download a font from “dafont.com” to help express the mood. (See Mrs. Carmon)  
fear  
bizarre  
stagnant  
enticing  
illusion  
memory  
organic  
void  
tactile  
unconscious  
dream
3. Find a picture that reflects word on the internet. Download a texture onto your desktop and then place the texture below text layer.



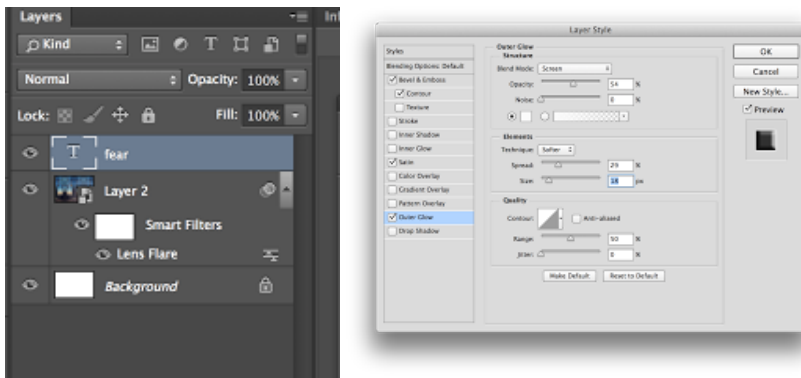
4. Convert image layer to a smart filter layer **Filter->Convert Smart Filter layer**



5. Now use a filter or several filters by **Filter-> “pick one,” in my example I chose lens flare.**

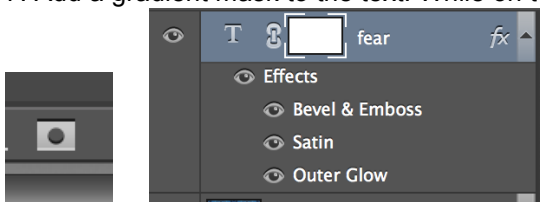


6. OK now **double click on Text layer**. This will pull open the layer style menu.

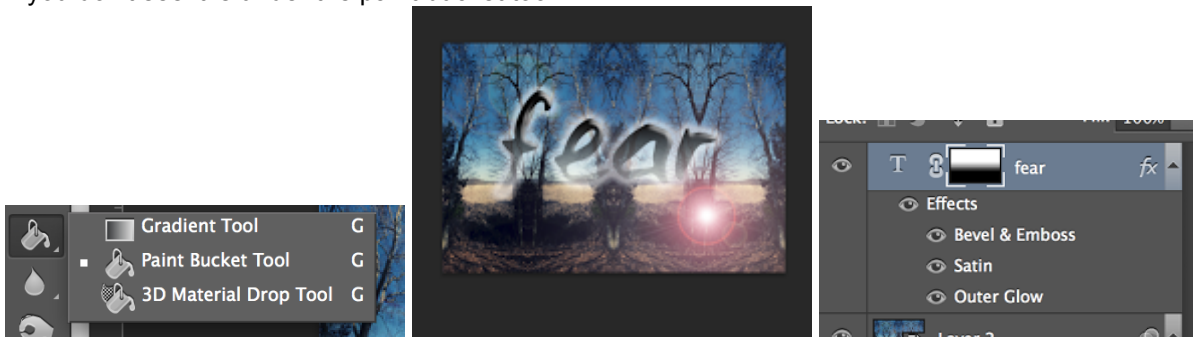


Now play with layer styles. On my example I did bevel, satin, and outside glow.

7. Add a gradient mask to the text. While on text layer click on the add vector mask at the bottom of layers menu



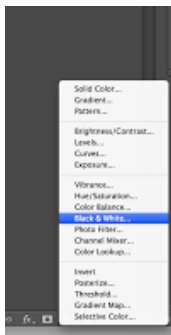
8. The white mask will pop up next to text. Make sure you are on the white square. Go to toolbox and select gradient. If you don't see it is under the paint bucket tool.



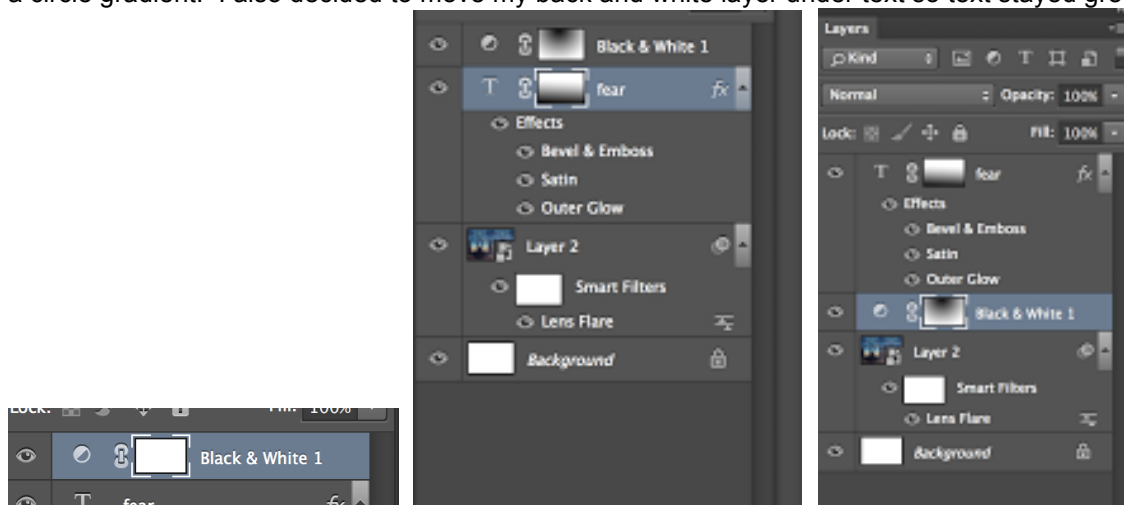
9. Drag and drop the gradient tool till you like the look of your transparent blend.

10. **Click on Texture Layer** now add a Black and white adjustment layer.

**Click on new adjustment layer.**  **Click black and white**



11. Now on the vector mask (white box is clicked) make a another gradient on the canvas I changed mine to a circle gradient. I also decided to move my back and white layer under text so text stayed green.



10. Save as a Photoshop file Last Name First Name\_Fear Flash Card.

11. Repeat process for all 11 words. Each word should use a different filter.
